



WORKSHOP ON SUCCESSFUL CASES

November 4th, 2008 Radisson Royal Hotel Bogotá, Colombia

1. BACKGROUND

The forum opened up by IIRSA Initiative has fostered innovations in planning techniques for the territorial dimension and the regional vision of infrastructure and the integration of complementary sectors, such as transportation, energy and telecommunications, taking into account relevant social, economic, environmental and competitiveness-related aspects. Additionally, the collective and consensus-building approach inherent to the Initiative since its creation has promoted cooperation among South American countries, the most outstanding example being the "Exports through Postal Services for Micro, Small and Medium-Sized Enterprises" project. The government of Brazil, with the support of FOMIN, is advising the Ecuadorian, Peruvian and Uruguayan governments in implementing a service that should enlarge access to new export markets by using Exporta Fácil as a model, a project implemented by the Postal Service in Brazil in 1999.¹

IIRSA member countries have decided to include this experience in their work plan extending this cooperation model to other successful cases available in the region concerning the provision of infrastructure services in areas such as road safety, border passes, urban transport or access to information and communication technologies, among others.

To this end, the Executive Steering Committee of IIRSA (CDE), which in 2008 has been presided over by the Colombian delegation through its National Planning Department (DNP), is organizing the "Workshop on Successful Cases", scheduled for the week during which the XIII Meeting of IIRSA National Coordinators will be held.

2. OBJECTIVE

The main objective of this regional event is to set in motion a process of experience interchange among South American governments by presenting successful initiatives that might be replicated in any interested country. This workshop will foster the creation of a regional network for the exchange of successful cases in the provision of infrastructure services.
